

50th Vietnam War Anniversary Commemoration



KDVA honors all veterans every day, but for the next nine10 years we will be focusing on Vietnam War veterans. Decades after they came home to no parades, no recognition and no thanks, Congress has declared the 50th Anniversary Vietnam War Commemoration.

Here in the Commonwealth we have approximately 116,000 Vietnam Veterans. About 8,000 of those are women. About 8,000 are African-American or Hispanic. They live and work in all 120 counties. They, like many groups of veterans we have honored, are worthy of the national 12-year-long Commemoration.

The purpose of the Commemoration is to recognize, honor and thank the Vietnam veterans in our communities.
