Physical therapy and recreational activities are available to help our residents achieve their ultimate functioning abilities. Admission Criteria

- Must be a veteran with an other than dishonorable discharge, a current resident of the Commonwealth, and in need of skilled nursing care.
- Prior to admission, each application is reviewed to ensure that medical needs of the veteran can be met.
- No individual shall be denied admission based on the grounds of race, color, handicap, age, gender, religion, national origin or HIV status.

Thomson-Hood Veterans Center



Kentucky's first facility opened in August 1991. The 285-bed facility is located on 30 acres of beautiful rolling farmland 15 miles south of Lexington in the city of Wilmore.
