We are proud to announce a new program (VTS), The Veterans Transportation System. Our Program will compliment and support the mission of the Disabled American Veterans (VTN), Volunteer Transportation Network.

VTS provides an additional transportation option for Veterans that is **FREE** and is available to any Veteran in our service area who is enrolled for care at our medical center.

VTS will begin its first route on Wednesday, March 20<sup>th</sup> 2013, from Lexington VA Medical Center to the Hazard CBOC, (Community Based Outpatient Clinic), with stops in the following cities: **Stanton, Campton and Jackson**. We can transport Veterans to The Lexington VAMC **OR** to the CBOC in Hazard.

VTS can transport up to eight (8) passengers and two (2) wheelchairs. If you live or know of a Veteran who lives in **Perry, Breathitt, Owsley, Lee, Wolfe, Estill and Powell counties** who need transportation assistance, we'd like to help.

We will take Reservations as far as 1 year in advance, **but please try to call 48 hours in advance**. This is a first come, first serve, **FREE** service.
