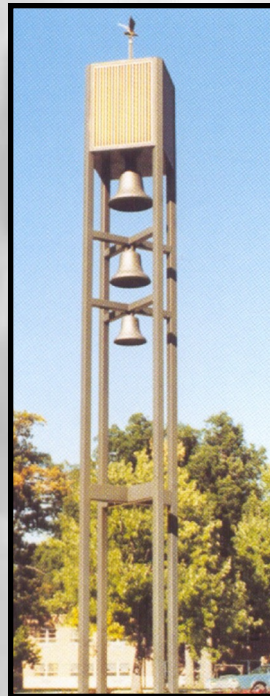


Sample Memorial Paver

MEMORIAL PAVERS

Memorial pavers are placed in cemetery walkways such as Flag Plaza, the Committal Shelter, and will also be placed at the base of the Carillon Tower upon its construction. Each paver will allow 13 spaces per line with a maximum of 3 lines.

CARILLON



Upon receipt of enough donations, a carillon, similar to this one, will be constructed on the hill in front of the Admin Building. The carillon will provide beautiful digital bell renditions of hymns at the beginning of each hour of the day.
