All of our homes are outfitted with state-of-the-art equipment. Physical therapy and recreational activities are available to help our residents achieve their ultimate functioning abilities. 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### Admission Criteria

- Must be a veteran with an other than dishonorable discharge, a current resident of the Commonwealth, and in need of nursing care.
- Prior to admission, each application is reviewed to ensure that medical needs of the veteran can be met.
- No individual shall be denied admission based on the grounds of race, color, handicap, age, gender, religion, national origin or HIV status.

### Thomson-Hood Veterans Center
